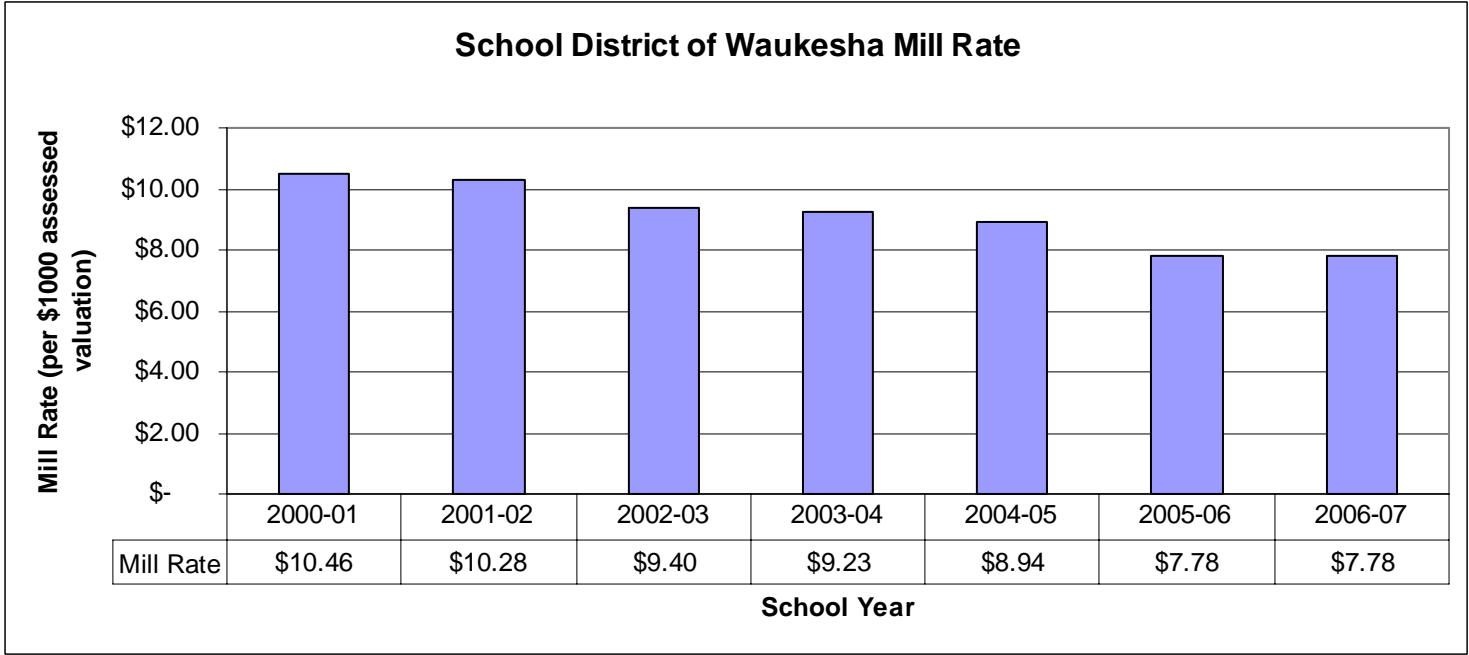


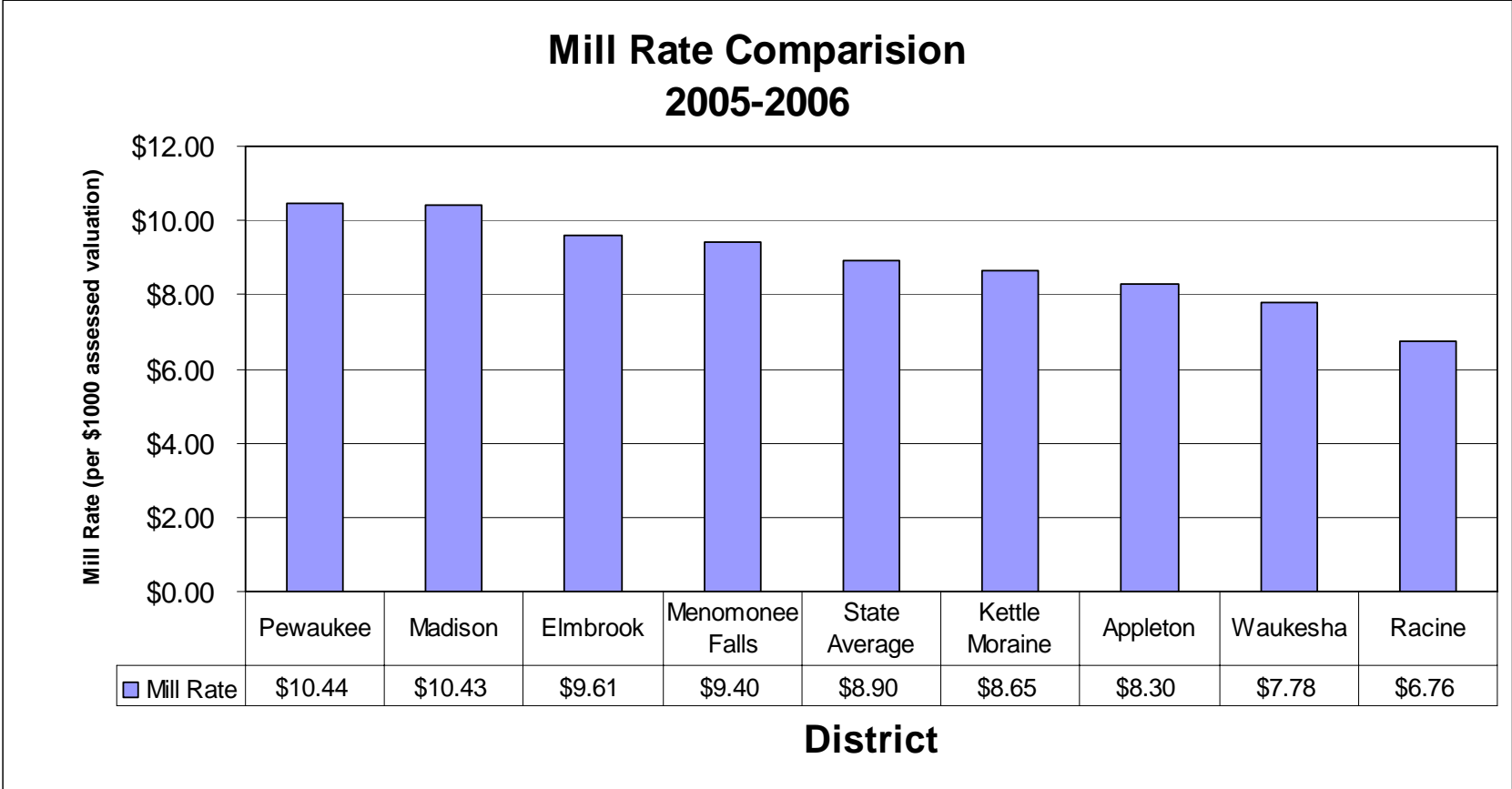
Waukesha School District Mill Rate



- In 2000, a homeowner with a home assessed at \$200,000 located in the Waukesha School District would have paid \$2,092 in property taxes for the schools.
- In 2006, a that same homeowner who’s house is now assessed at \$250,000 would have paid \$1,945 or \$147 less than 2000 despite an increase in value of the property.

Mill Rate Comparison



In Pewaukee a property owner with a home assessed at \$250,000 would have paid \$2,610 in school taxes. That same home in Waukesha would have only had \$1,945 in school taxes. That is a difference of \$655.
